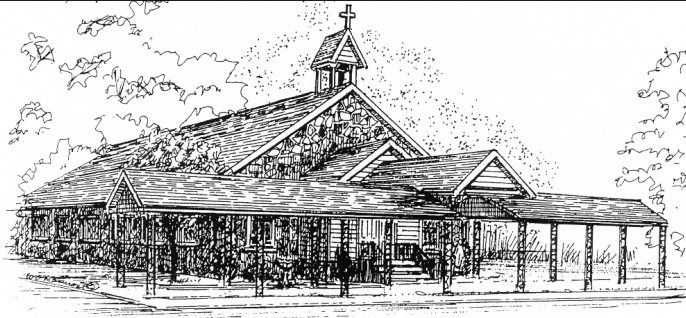

DEPENDING ON GOD

"Getting by with a little help from our friends" is not an idea that began with the Beatles. Certainly the idea of "getting by with a little help from God" goes back at least to the first reading today from Exodus. How we get that help, however, is the key to this weekend's scriptures.

No matter how inadequate Moses felt to the task God had given him, he persevered—even though he needed help from the people around him. The Israelites especially depended on God for freedom. The woman in the Gospel, desperate and destitute, had no one to depend on, but still she would not give up. She could not afford to bribe the unscrupulous judge, but she pestered him into weariness until finally he met her demands.

We sometimes need to turn to others to help us through difficult times; but if we always turn to God, we won't be disappointed, for our help, the psalm assures us, is from the Lord.

Question: My adult children do not attend this parish, but I would like to have a family picture with my adult children and my grandchildren. Can I do that?

Answer: YES you can! Make an appointment for your household, and then make an extra appointment for a photography session for your extended family. If your adult children and grandchildren want their own photo session for their family picture, they can schedule a session too. Just make sure when they schedule their appointment to make a note that they are not a member and their photo should not be put in our directory. They will also get a free 8 x10 from their photo session.

Question: I am willing to get my photo taken for the church directory, but how can I keep my cell phone number from being published?

Answer: When you schedule your appointment with one of our parish volunteers, they will ask you to verify your contact information. They will also ask you what information you want in the directory. You can even request not to have any information published. **YOU get to control the information to be published in the directory.**

Question: I am out of town the week our parish will be taking photos. Will there be a make-up session?

Answer: No, however you can submit a non-copyrighted digital picture for the directory by November 3rd for a \$10 handling fee. You will also need to sign a permission form allowing Re:MEMBER church directories to publish your photo.
