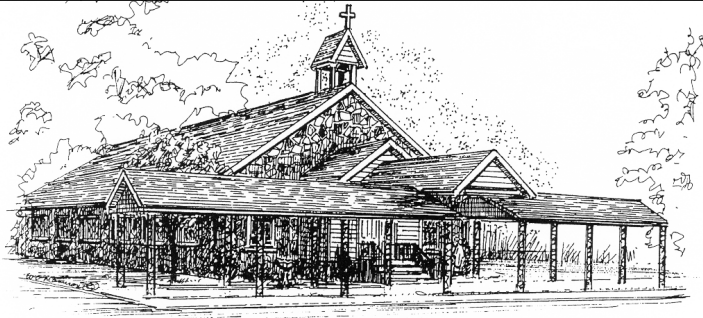

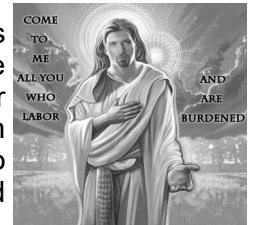

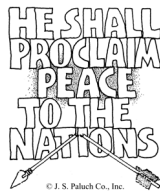
A HUMBLE KING

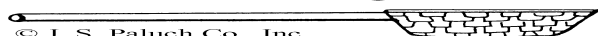
